Castaway recalls bygone romances
 “*There's No Tomorrow*” – Folk Song / Hoffman, Corday, Carr

The rescue begins----- Watch for SING ALONG Lyrics
 “*Sailing Sailing*” – Mark

Castaway reveals who he is and how he was marooned
 “*O! Man River*” – Kern/Hammerstein

Castaway tells of his companions on the island ---- Watch Minnie !
 “*Little Sir Echo*” – Smith/Fearis

Castaway says goodbye to his island home as he is welcomed aboard
 “*This Ole House*” – Hamblen ----- Watch for SING ALONG Lyrics
 “*Y'all Come*” (chorus) – Arlie Duff ----- Watch for SING ALONG Lyrics

“A little traveling music” as ship is boarded and heads out to sea

ORGAN describes the breaking dawn
 “*Morning*” - Grieg's *Peer Gynt*

Two passengers greet the morning in individual ways
 “*Daybreak*” – Adamson/Grofe
 “*Oh What a Beautiful Morning*” - Rodgers/Hammerstein

Crew members reassure the Captain that all is well
 “*He's Got the Whole World in His Hands*” - Traditional Spiritual

Verse 1: He's got the whole world ...
 Verse 2: He's got the tiny little baby ...
 Verse 3: He's got everybody here ...



Organ signals that Pirates are sighted! 

A passenger fears her virtue is threatened!
 “*Cain't Say No*” – Rodgers/Hammerstein

The pirates approach and board the vessel
 “*Pirate King*” (chorus) – Gilbert/Sullivan
 “*Buttercup*” – Gilbert/Sullivan

Romantic encounter leads to a rescue ----- Watch for SING ALONG Lyrics
 “*Whistle While You Work*”- Churchill/Morey

The former lovers must go their separate ways on the High Seas
 “*Spanish Eyes*”- Kaempfert/Singleton/Snyder

The castaway reminds us that life is meant for joy---- Watch for SING ALONG Lyrics
 “*Funiculi Funicula*” – Denza/Oxenford

We see the mainland ----- Watch for SING ALONG Lyrics
 “*Dear Hearts and Gentle People*” - Hilliard/Fain
 “*America the Beautiful*” - Bates/Ward ----- Watch for SING ALONG Lyrics
