Grab a partner or come alone

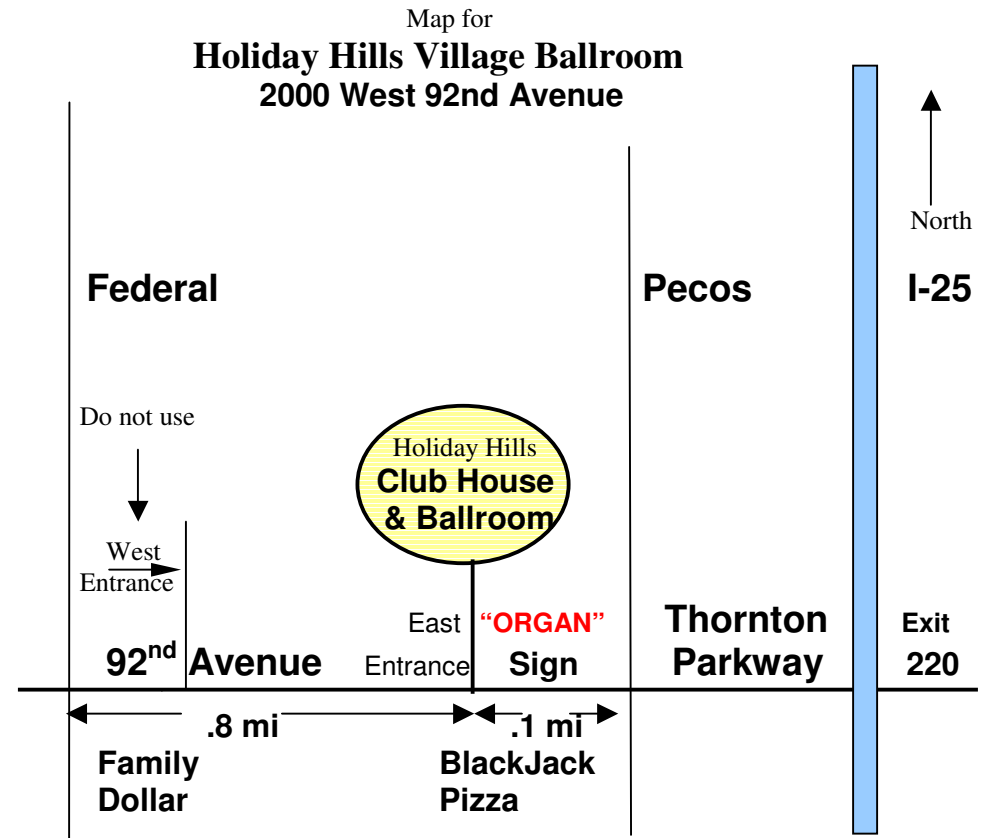
Even if you don't dance, you won't want to miss the fun and the music

From the East, from I-25 take Thornton Parkway West to 92nd & Pecos. Continue west on 92nd to the first street on the right (north). (Thornton Parkway becomes 92nd Avenue at Pecos)

From the West, take 92nd going East and look for second (East) entrance to Holiday Hills on your left. If you get to Pecos, you've gone too far!

From Holiday Hills entrance at 2000 W. 92nd, go straight ahead on Holiday Blvd to end of street. Turn left. Ballroom is on the right.

There is usually an “ORGAN” sign at the Holiday Hills Village entrance. Free parking in ballroom lot or on nearby streets around the ballroom.

The Holiday Hills Ballroom is handicapped/wheelchair accessible. The Holiday Hills Ballroom is a smoke-free environment.
