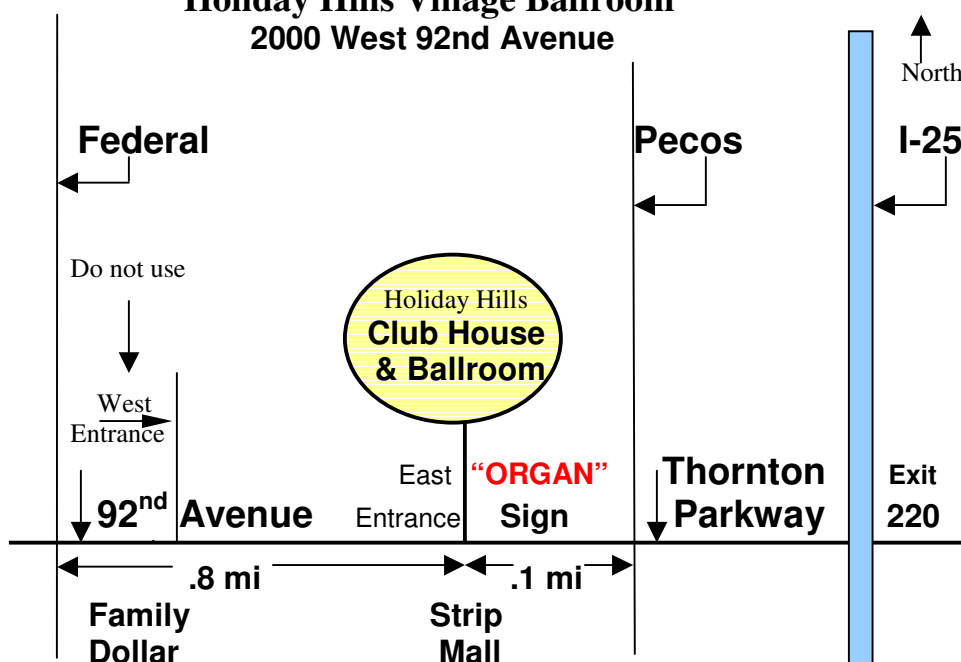

From the East, from I-25 take Thornton Parkway West to 92nd & Pecos. Continue west on 92nd to the first street on the right (north). (Thornton Parkway becomes 92nd Avenue at Pecos)

From the West, take 92nd going East and look for second (East) entrance to Holiday Hills on your left. If you get to Pecos, you've gone too far!

From Holiday Hills entrance at 2000 W. 92nd, go straight ahead on Holiday Blvd to the end of the street. Turn left. Ballroom is in the clubhouse on the right.
