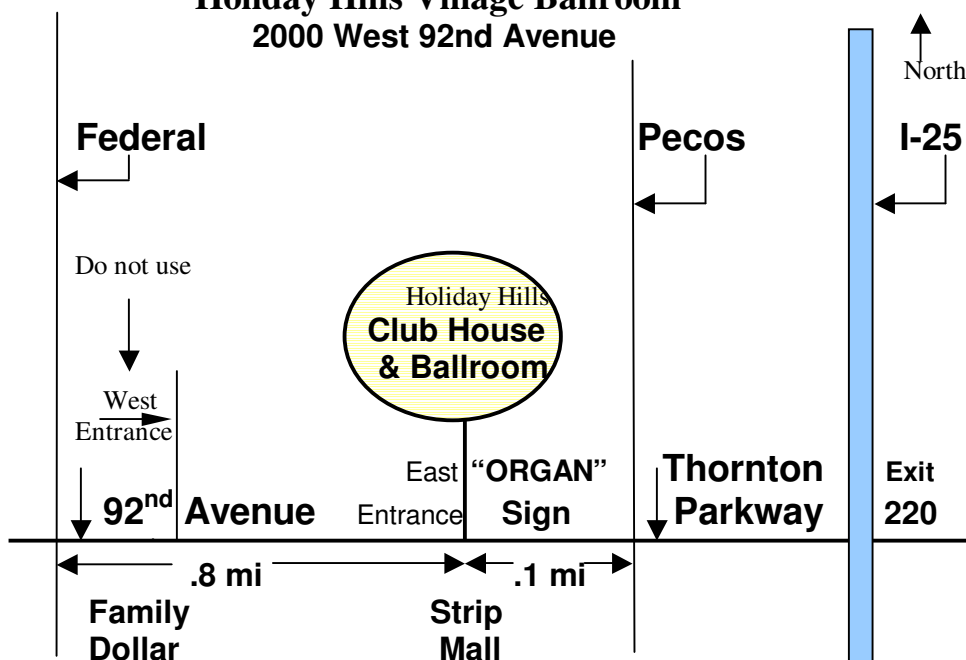

From the East, from I-25 take Thornton Parkway West to 92<sup>nd</sup> & Pecos. Continue west on 92<sup>nd</sup> to the first street on the right (north). (Thornton Parkway becomes 92<sup>nd</sup> Avenue at Pecos)

From the West, take 92<sup>nd</sup> going East and look for second (East) entrance to Holiday Hills on your left. If you get to Pecos, you’ve gone too far!

From Holiday Hills entrance at 2000 W. 92<sup>nd</sup>, go straight ahead on Holiday Blvd to the end of the street. Turn left. Ballroom is in the clubhouse on the right.
