Back by popular demand..... Bob Ralston Plays

the Paramount

Sunday, October 23rd, 2 pm Monday, October 24th, 2 pm Denver's Paramount Theatre Adults \$12, Students \$6 *(Both dates are RTD Senior Ride events)*

The time has come! Bob Ralston from the Lawrence Welk show in concert with two afternoon performances playing the Denver Paramount's Mighty Wurlitzer theatre pipe organ and the grand piano.



Bob Ralston has been a star of the Lawrence Welk TV show for over 42 years and is still seen weekly by more than 10 million viewers. At the Paramount Bob will perform an entertaining two-hour pops concert on the Mighty Wurlitzer and the grand piano (and rumor has it he'll even be playing both at the same time!). You may want to attend both shows!

A "steal" at \$12 for adults, \$6 for students, tickets are for a single performance but they are valid for either date so if you have a last-minute schedule change you can switch performances without having to exchange tickets.

Take the Bus!

Both of the Bob Ralston performances are RTD Senior Ride events. That means if you sign up with one of the Senior Ride groups, you can get door-todoor transportation from that group's location to the Paramount and back. For those 65 or older the round trip fare is \$1.25. For all others, \$2.50 round trip. A person of any age can take the Senior Ride.

Holiday Hills is one of the RTD Senior Ride groups. Call Sally Peterson, **303-657-9655** and make your reservation for one or both performances. There is a minimum of 10 riders for pick-up. Bus fare is paid to the bus driver, tickets to the show must be purchased in advance or at the door.

You can also take **RTD light rail** at regular rates, and get off at California & 16^{th} St. mall. The Paramount is two blocks east at Glenarm & 16^{th} St. mall.
