For those timid organists who have always longed to play the Paramount's Mighty Wurlitzer but were afraid to try it for fear that someone might be listening have we got a deal for you!

Because of our August 8th use of the theatre, the master Wurlitzer console will be "up" and "uncapped" from July 30th to August 16th.

During that time we are scheduling several dates when members can sign up for one or two hours of time and "do their own thing". It can be done



"alone" or you may bring an entire entourage of doting admirers and have the theatre all to yourself!

There are some costs involved, so there will be a charge of \$5 per

hour for the organist. There is no charge for the entourage. If no one has reserved time before or after your original slot, you may use additional hours.

Call Lee Shaw (**303-530-2421**) and reserve your time. You will even be able to set your own pistons, etc. just like the professionals!

Potential dates are: July 31, August 1,2,12,14,15. Potential hours are from 10 am until 7 pm.

Other dates may be available. Management reserves the right to help you decide what dates and times you might schedule your usage.

Paramount Wurlitzer Lift Repairs

Update: The lift for the Paramount Wurlitizer's master organ console has been repaired.

New heavy rollers were custom machined; old cross braces were replaced and strengthened with a metal plate; all bolts were replaced; the back side of the heavy metal I beam tracks had become bent over the years and could not be straightened.

To solve the bent beam problem, the new lower support rollers now ride on the outside of the Ibeams. Plans have been made to construct a "rest area" for the console in the bottom of the pit. That will remove the weight of the console from the lift tracks when the console is resting in the bottom of the orchestra pit. The console itself, during it's 80-year residency and many trips in and out of the orchestra pit, had "wiggled" several inches off center. It has been moved back to a better structural position.

Our thanks to **Gabe Jensen**, the Paramount Production Manager; **Allison Hamiliton**, the Paramount Manager and **Kroenke Sports**, the Paramount owner for making sure these repairs were made.

Interested in seeing the modifications? Tours to the orchestra pit will be available at our August 8th social at the theatre.
