

Red, White & Blue Ragtime Revue

A wonderful afternoon of musical entertainment for all ages will take place at the Denver Paramount on Sunday, October 16th, at 2 pm as **Dave Wickerham** at the console of the Mighty Wurlitzer and **Dick Kroeckel** at the Steinway concert grand piano present their Red, White & Blue Ragtime Revue!



Dave and Dick have performed similar concerts together receiving standing ovations and wild cheers of approval from audiences throughout the entire United States.

Dave Wickerham is the resident organist / curator for the Milhous Collection & Museum in Boca Raton, Florida. He is known internationally for his work as a solo theatre organist. Dave has been featured at the Denver Paramount in past years at the Footloose and Footloose II theatre organ events.

Dick Kroeckel is a noted piano technician and restorer of player pianos. He started his professional playing career in Evergreen, Colorado and for years was a ragtime pianist at a number of Colorado restaurants and casinos. Dick has also had prior performances at the Denver Paramount.

A number of surprises have been planned as ragtime and other musical styles (interspersed with enjoyable patter) are played on the theatre pipe organ or concert grand piano both alone and together.

This is something the whole family will enjoy and students 18 and under are admitted free!

Adult tickets are \$12 and include free parking at ramps on Welton and Tremont, each just a block from the theatre. Tickets may be purchased at the door, at RMCATOS events, or via the Internet at www.TicketHorse.com. Ticket Horse tickets will be \$13 and include a \$1 convenience fee.

The Ragtime Revue will be the first public performance utilizing the newly re-installed original second vox humana pipe rank. See if you can hear the difference the additional pipe rank makes.

Bus fare is paid in exact change when boarding the bus. A ticket to the show (\$12) is purchased separately and may be bought prior to boarding the bus.

Prior to the show, the audience was shown a video presentation of Paramount and Wurlitzer facts and glimpses of past RMCATOS events at the theatre.

In the lobby, Jud Murphy manned the "how a pipe organ works" demo and showed the newly acquired copies, from the Smithsonian, of the original 1930 Wurlitzer theatre organ installation blue prints.

410 Building Parking Ramp -- 1692 Tremont Place On right side of one-way Tremont ... Traditional parking ramp

Dominion Towers Garage -- 1607 Welton Street
On left side of one-way Welton ... "Paramount Parking" sign at entrance

For either location, drive in and park. Pay upon exit.

When exiting, present Paramount ticket stub for free parking.

Both ramps open 2 hours before the show & close 90 minutes after the show.
