What a wonderful Wurlitzer afternoon... "Sunday Surprise"

Just over 125 RMCATOS and AGO members arrived at the Denver Paramount on Sunday, August 12th, for our "free day at the Paramount" thanks to the Paramount staff.

Prior to the show, the audience was shown a video presentation of Paramount and Wurlitzer facts and glimpses of past RMCATOS events at the theatre.

The program consisted of six current or former church organists. Each are members or past members of the American Guild of Organists (AGO).

The six organists that played, listed in alphabetical sequence, were Bryan Dunnewald, **Ingrid Gardner, DeLoy Goeglein, Ken Mervine,** Frank Perko III and Joel Trekell.



We were delighted that Bryan and Joel, both high school students, were able to participate in the performance.

As it turned out, based on their position in the program, the students had the honor of playing the appropriate music while riding the 82-year-old Wurlitzer console out of and into the orchestra pit!

"Sunday Surprise" was the first time we used our new "eye in the sky" remote video camera located near the ceiling, 55 feet above the console. The picture was projected on the Paramount's "big screen".

Another first was the live video camera in the solo pipe chamber focused on the two sections of the wood harp percussion unit.

The performers provided a wonderful array of musical moods and styles, from mellow arias, to Sousa marches, to the world premier of "Symphony of Grace" composed for Ken & Barbara Mervine by Joel Raney.

The program closed with "Night on Bald Mountain" with Frank Perko III at the console. The dust is still settling. Frank descended into the pit playing "Paramount on Parade" while scenes of the Denver Paramount and RMCATOS Wurlitzer events played on the big screen.

A walking theatre tour was provided after the event for those who were interested.
