This is the 10th anniversary of Doors Open Denver (DOD). Over 80 buildings, all around Denver, will be open for the public to visit at no charge. The event runs Saturday and Sunday, April 12th & 13th.

There is a comedian show booked at the Paramount the evening of the 12^{th} , and although we think we can have the theatre until 2 pm on Saturday, that has not been confirmed by the Paramount.

Each day RMCATOS will be providing non-stop, live, Mighty Wurlitzer theatre organ music with the organists changing every thirty minutes.

There will also be Paramount Theatre tours, a demo of how organ pipes work and copies of the original 1930's Wurlitzer blue prints for the Paramount's twin console organ installation.

Come to the theatre whenever you wish (after 10 am) and stay as long or as short as you like (until closing). Use the theatre as your Doors Open Denver "headquarters" as you visit other open sites.

A list of all buildings participating in 2014, along with a map of all locations, will be published in local newspapers.
