"Pipes & Stripes" returns to the Denver Paramount for its ninth annual presentation. The successful series joins the Rocky Mountain Brassworks and the 101st Army Band of the Colorado National Guard Centennial Wind Ensemble with the Paramount's 1930 Mighty Wurlitzer theatre pipe organ. The event is once again sponsored by Kroenke Sports Charities and RMCATOS. There will be no admission charge and no tickets are needed.
