"DELOY DOES DEMUSIC .. AGAIN!"

DeLoy Goeglein has been an organist for most of his life, has performed on most of the organs around Denver and owned more organs than 99.999% of people on the planet. He has been the organist at Bethlehem Lutheran Church on Wadsworth for half a century and was one of the organists at the sorelymissed Denver Organ Grinder pizza restaurant. In fact, he was the last Grinder organist, receiving the sad news of its imminent closure while playing his usual gig on that amazing, one-of-a-kind Wurlitzer. The audience didn't want the music to stop, DeLoy kept the tunes coming and gave that beautiful organ the send-off it deserved. This is just one of DeLoy's many stories of wonderful music, semi-pro golf, fast cars with knee-deep paint jobs, strong Lutheran faith, music education, church organ and carillon salesman, blizzard road-trips, developing new handbell ringing styles and encounters with famous people and places. DeLoy is very active as pianist with the "Generations Trio" and performs in retirement homes across the Denver area multiple times each week. DeLoy's life-long fascination with sacred, classical and popular organ music will DeLight our audience in September as DeLoy brings these styles together with his patented flair. These organs are mounted on easy-rolling folding platforms that can fit through a 32" door to bring organ music anywhere. Jim performed a variety of tunes on the GW4Q digital computer organ, used the auto-play feature to accompany vocal, tuba and pocket trumpet solos, and demonstrated each of the Touring Organs. Bob Castle, Lee Traster and DeLoy Goeglein climbed aboard and joined in for an extended 8-handed audience request finale.
