Walt shared stories about the development of his Walt Strony signature digital organ and its connection to George Wright’s studio Wurlitzer and generously shared a comprehensive stop-list of all of his registrations with each of the participants. The feature-length silent movie was filled with action scenes, romance, and music that artistically identified the actors and framed the action. The concert featured Walt at his outstanding best performing on an Allen STR-4 that filled the house and reached new audiences of all ages eager for more theatre organ music events.
