About the Artists

Thomas Alexander was born in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, in 1980. At seventeen he had his first performance with an orchestra when he played George Gershwin's Rhapsody in Blue.

In 2004 he performed an improvisation on Fur Elise on Garrison Keillor's nationally known Prairie Home Companion radio show.

Thomas has been a guest artist with Bob Ralston (of the Lawrence Welk Show) at performances in Sioux City, Iowa and at the Denver Paramount Theatre.

With a Ph.D. from the Sweelinck Conservatory in Amsterdam, Thomas has won many piano and improvisation competitions, performed throughout Europe and the USA, has made two CD recordings and will soon release a third CD of improvisations.

During today's performance, Thomas will be asking the audience for requests for songs for improvisation..... so start thinking of your favorite tunes.

Thomas is in the process of becoming a US citizen and has lived, since 2003, in Sioux City, Iowa with his wife, Lisa.

Bev Bucci is a resident of Brighton, Colorado. She is a church organist, plays keyboards for senior dances and has traveled with a polka band playing piano, accordion and trombone.

Jim Calm lives in Lakewood and teaches music in the Jeffco public schools. He is a church organist, a banjo band member, a tuba player and former organist at the Organ Grinder pizza parlor.

Bob Castle is a Denver native and has been the house organist for the Mighty Wurlitzer theatre pipe organ at Denver's Paramount Theatre since the early 1950's playing for all occasions.
